 allotted to the Complainants in right of Elizabeth, the wife of Samuel Washburn, one to  
 Robert Fort, one to Temperance Myrick, one to Eliza Fort, and the remaining equally

 the land is not worth three hundred dollars in the opinion of the Commissioners herein after  
 appointed, then it is decreed that the said land be sold on a credit of twelve months and the  
 proceeds divided into five equal parts and secured by bonds with approved security and the bond  
 allotted to the Complainants and the said mentioned defendants in the same proportion, and
