

1820 We the undersigned have proceeded to divide the negroes belonging to the estate of S^r deceased in manner and form as follows to wit
First to value and proportion the advancements, secondly to allot the remaining negroes into four lots as equal as could be, which was drawn by the lotter as follows -

Lot N^o 1 drawn by Joseph Bellam.

Lot N^o 2 " by Thomas B Turner

Lot N^o 3 " by Thomas Barwell

Lot N^o 4 " by Edith Harris

For the inequalities of lots it appears that Edith Harris must pay to Joseph Bellam \$137.52 1/4 and to Thomas B Turner \$41.16 and Thomas Barwell must pay Thomas B Turner \$6.92 1/4 all which more fully appears by reference to the following statement
