 have and have appraised them to 25 dollars each amounting to 125 dollars and have
 assigned to Minniefred Drew widow of James Drew one of the s^d beds, to Jeremiah Drew
 son of James Drew dec^r one feather bed and furniture to James Drew son of s^d James
 Drew one ditto, to Sarah Drew son of s^d James Drew dec^r one ditto and to Jesse Drew
 son of s^d James Drew dec^r one other feather bed & furniture. which finishes the division
 of the beds. Also all the Commissioners in order to make an equal division to the widow &
 among the legates, we have ascertained the amount of the first payments made to the
 different claimants in the estate by Minniefred Drew widow and relief of James Drew
 and also Eric of s^d dec^r and find that she has paid out 690.50 Principle & \$198.15
 and making \$888.65 and she the s^d Eric has received from the estate 695 dollars
 principle & 534.88 cents with which makes 1229.88. the s^d Eric has received - Cents
 44.25. The Executive is indebted to the estate of which Minniefred Drew the Executive
 of said draws \$3 each which is 8.25. And she then pays to Jeremiah Drew 8.25
