that is to say the said George Stearns in the sum of \$100. and the said William
 Shepherd and Jephias in the sum of \$33 1/3. each of their respective goods and chattels, lands
 and tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commons
 lawfully rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said George Stearns shall keep
 the peace and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth more espe-
 cially towards Patrick Pond, for the term of twelve months from this day then the above
 recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue —

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning ten o'clock —
