

to act with those heretofore appointed, to carry into effect the interlocutory decree made in this cause on the day of August 1821. and it is ordered that any two of the said Commissioners do carry the aforesaid interlocutory decree into effect and make report thereof to Court.

John Farrell who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of Lewis M Bay against him for a breach of the peace this day appeared accordingly. Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the said complaint be dismissed.

The persons appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Flat Swamp bridge, this day made a report in these words to wit. "Agreeably to the annexed order we the undersigned have proceeded to let the repairs of the Flat Swamp bridge at which letting John Mammack became the undertaker for fifteen dollars and ninety six cents the said Mammack having completed the same agreeable to the terms and contract, we now think proper, in obedience to said decree, to certify the Court thereof. Given under our hands this 12th day of April 1822 Farrell Turner. Benj Turner."

Whereupon the said report is ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb do examine state and settle an account of Anthony Woodards administration as William Sykes's estate and make report thereof to Court.

Elijah Johnson who is charged on oath by Elizabeth Lewis single woman with being the father of her bastard child. this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into at the last Court. and thereupon the said Elizabeth Lewis being sworn and examined and the said Elijah Johnson fully heard, the Court from all the circumstances of the case doth adjudge the said Elijah Johnson to be the father of the said bastard child and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the County. Therefore it is ordered that he be charged with the annual payment of twenty dollars to the Overseers of the Poor of this County for the maintenance of said child for the space of seven years from this day in case the said child shall live so long and pay the same to them accordingly at the end of every year until the expiration of the said seven years. And it is further ordered that the said Elijah Johnson enter into a recognizance himself in the sum of \$140. with two securities in the sum of \$70. each payable to the Governor of this Commonwealth for the time being, and his successors, to observe and perform the above order of the Court and the said Johnson being unable to find such security, and wishing to discharge himself from custody and Can Bowers one of the Overseers of the Poor here in Court acknowledges that he received notice of the petition of the said Johnson that he may be permitted to take the benefit of the oath for the relief of insolvent debtors. Whereupon the said Elijah Johnson here in Court subscribed and delivered in a Schedule of his estate
