Calvert with Samuel Calvert and Menewether B. Bradman his securities here in Court
severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to his excellency Thomas Mann Randolph
esq. Governor or Chief magistrate of this Commonwealth, the said Calvert in the sum of
\$300. and the said S. Calvert & Bradman in the sum of \$150 each of their respective
lands and tenements, goods and chattels to be levied, and to our said Governor and his successors
for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Matt.
Calvert shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Com-
monwealth more especially towards the said David Callender for the term of
twelve months as aforesaid then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force -
