

additional report. *Writ.* That whereas there is a certain infirm old negro woman belonging to the said estate, by the name of Sally, valued in our Judgment to be worth nothing and that an expense is likely to be incurred to the said estate by the said negro woman who was not taken into the estimate with the effective slaves in the division required to be made by the said order, of course she remains as a part of the orphan's estate, we do therefore upon second consideration thereof, with due regard to the interest of all the parties, report as our opinion that the said Narcissa Turner do in future during her life pay one third of all expenses that may be incurred to the said estate by the said negro woman, being done as we think in conformity to the requisition of said order, and in order to a final decree - Thomas Moore, Wm. J. Smith, Willie Francis, Henry Porter. Whereupon by consent of parties by their Attornies it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be confirmed. And that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne between the parties.
