maintain her action in her individual character. Therefore it is considered
that the said Judgment be reversed and annulled, and that the Appel-
lant recover against the appellee his costs by him expended in prosecuting
his appeal aforesaid here. And this Court proceeding to give such Judg-
ment as the said Justice ought to have given doth order that the said
warrant be dismissed and that the appellant recover against the Appellee
his costs by him in his defense before the said Justice expended.
