

Edwin Turner from his recognizance and undertaking in this part is discharged. And on the prayer of the plaintiff by his attorney, the said defendant is committed to the custody of the Sheriff of this County to remain in the common Jail for debtors until he shall be discharged by due course of law; and thereupon the said defendant acknowledged the plaintiff's action for thirty six dollars and sixty five cents with interest thereon from the 17th day of April 1822 till paid. Therefore it is concluded by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the said sum of thirty six dollars and sixty five cents with legal interest thereon from the 17th day of April 1822 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And the said defendant on Motion of P. And it appearing to the Court that the plaintiff had reasonable notice of the petition of the defendant that he may be permitted to take the benefit of the Act for the relief of insolvent debtors, the said defendant in open Court submitted and delivered in a Schedule of his estate and made oaths thereto as the law directs it is ordered that he be discharged out of custody.

Leonard Atkinson late of the County of Southampton and Parish of Stottorney who stands charged with feloniously drawing nails and breaking into the lock of William West on the night of the 6th of July last past, and stealing, taking & carrying away three bushels of Indian corn the property of said William West was this day set to the bar by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid (the Court summoned for his examination not having met) and thereupon William West the witness on behalf of the Commonwealth was sworn and examined touching the premises, and the prisoner being fully heard by himself. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the said Leonard Atkinson ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior Court of Law to be held for this County. And thereupon the prisoner is remanded to Jail.
