It is upon this condition that if the said (William West) shall personally appear before the Judge of the Superior Court of Law of this County at the Court house on the first day of the next Term by ten O'clock of that day and there and there give such evidence as he knows or believes in behalf of the Commonwealth against Leonard Atkinson who stands charged with Petit Larceny and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Ordered that the estate of Amos Washington which remains undistributed by the former administrator be committed to the hands of Thomas Ridley Sheriff of this County and that he administer thereon according to Law.

The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior Court of Law to be held for this County, and thereupon he is remanded to Jail.
