It is decreed and ordered that James Rochelle and James Milliken convey by

this Court in order to a final decree.

edged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs
certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on Chasmon Nichol-
son's estate in due form.

Benjamin Applewhite or any three of them being sworn before a Justice of the
Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal Estate of Chasmon Nichol-
son dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that Kit, Raf and Rose negroes be put and placed on the poor
list of this County and that the Overseers of the poor take them under their care &
act with them according to Law.

Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor in the upper district of Norton
Parish bind out Sandy, Clary, Billy Ash, Sam Ash, Willis Holladay, Thomas
John Ransom, Jack New, George Mining, Robert Green, Hyatt Warren, Watson Jeff-
Miley, Carey, Gilbert Sykes, Sam New & John Green to Mrs. Ann Pickett according
to Law.

Ordered that Arthur Holliman, Harrison Stephenson, and Silas Sumner
or any two of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of Middle branch
bridge, and when the same is completed according to contract make report thereof to
Court.

Ordered that James Clayton, Samuel B. Sumner and Silas Sum-
ner or any two of them let to the lowest undertaker the Lower Sausch bridge
and when the same is completed according to contract make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Benjamin Hines, Samuel Barham and Thomas Fitzhugh
or any two of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs to Fords bridge and when
the same is completed according to contract make report thereof to Court.
