Whereupon the said Henry Robertson with Joel Williams and John Timmons his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to his Excellency Thomas M Randolph Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Henry Robertson in the sum of \$50 and the said Joel Williams & John Timmons in the sum of \$25 each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition, if the said Henry Robertson shall keep the Peace and be of good behaviour towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens more especially towards the said Polly Blitch for the term of twelve months from this day then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Thomas E Brock who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the complaint of a breach of the peace against him appeared accordingly, and he being fully heard it is seems to the Court and it is accordingly ordered that the said Thomas E Brock find security for his good behaviour for the term of twelve months, that is to say, himself in the sum of \$100 with two securities to be bound in the sum of \$50 each. And thereupon the said Thomas E Brock with Baldy Drake and Lucy Brock his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Thomas M Randolph Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said Thomas E Brock in the sum of one hundred dollars and the said Baldy Drake and Lucy Brock in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Thomas E Brock shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of the Commonwealth for the term of twelve months from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.
