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said David Myrick deceased pay over to Joshua C Lundy as the Guardian of Susan S Lundy the sum of thirteen hundred and thirty seven dollars with interest thereon from the 31st day of December 1817 also one hundred and eighty five dollars and fifteen cents without any interest. The Court doth further adjudge order and decree that the said Joshua C Lundy Guardian to Susan S Lundy pay to the said James Myrick Executor of David Myrick dec^d the costs of the said report and account and other costs by him in this behalf expended.
