and is in these words and figures to wit.

Agreeable to an order of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing date
December Court 1820. we the undersigned as Commissioners appointed to divide the
slaves of Robert Miller dec'd of the County aforesaid hath in obedience therunto, divided
them among the legates in manner and form following to wit, We in the first place
laid off to James E. Miller lot N. 1. Solomon valued at \$400. Heester valued at \$150.
& Francis valued at \$150. making \$700. his full proportionable part of all the slaves
belonging to his deceased father after paying to William R. Miller lot N. 2. the sum of
\$25. which sum deducted from \$700 leaves \$675. each legates full proportion of
S. negroes. Also Ann R. Miller lot N. 2. Say Moses valued at \$400. Fereby
valued at \$200. & Peter valued at \$100. making \$700. being her part of the slaves
of said dec'd after paying lot N. 4. the sum of \$25. which sum being deducted from
\$700 leaves \$675. her full proportion of the negroes aforesaid. Also Lot N. 3 laid off to
Sarah C. Miller Say Peter valued at \$250. & Charity & child valued at \$450 making
\$700 her part of said negroes after paying to Lot N. 4 the sum of \$25. which sum
being deducted from \$700 leaves \$675. her full proportion of the slaves of S. dec'd.
Also William R. Miller lot N. 4 Say David \$300. & Henry \$400. making \$700
his part of said negroes after receiving from Lots N. 1, 2 & 3 the sum of \$25 each
which sums being added together makes \$675 his full proportionable part of all
the slaves of his said dec'd father. Given under our hands and seals this 21st day of
October 1822. Levi Waller (Seal) Nathl. Archibald (Seal) Jacob Williams (Seal).

On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that
the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held for as shall
and be binding between the parties forever. and that the costs of this suit be equally
