In Chancery

This cause was this day docketed and tried by consent of parties on the bill and answer, and the Court on mature consideration thereof doth adjudge, order and decree that Richard Abbot, William Phillips, Asa Harris, and John Thomas or any three of them do proceed with the assistance of the County Surveyor to lay off from the tract of land in Southampton County held by Elizabeth Cook deceased as her dower in the real estate of her deceased husband Lazarus Cook two sixth parts and allot the same to Lawrence Cook being his own proportion and that to which Miles Cook dec^d was entitled in his lifetime and which it appears to the Court he had regularly transferred to the said Lawrence. That the said Commissioners then divide the residue of the said land into four equal parts and allot one to Eliza Fort, the infant daughter of Joshua Fort and Martha his wife, that they allot one part to Rice W Pierce and Fanny his wife formerly Cook - that they divide one of the remaining shares into two equal parts, and allot one to Nathaniel Rochelle and Fanny his wife formerly Day and the other to John Turner infant son of Edwin Turner and Martha his wife which said Martha and Fanny were the issue of John Day and Elizabeth his wife dec^d formerly Cook. That they then subdivide the remaining portion into five equal parts and allot one to Richard Williamson and Martha his wife in right of his said wife - one part to Samuel Phipps & Mary his wife in right of his said wife - one part to Frank Edwards - one to Louisa Edwards and the remaining part to Rebecca Edwards infant daughter of John C Edwards deceased and all of whom are entitled conjointly to the proportion to which the said deceased mother Mary dec^d formerly Cook would have been entitled and that they report their proceedings in the premises to this Court in order to a final decree.

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
