

To be levied of the goods and chattels which shall hereafter come to the hands of the defendant to be administered after first satisfying all debts of superior debt to the plaintiffs demands. And the said defendant in Mercy &c.

The Court doth assign William Barnes guardian to Betty, Melt and Jegg Dick infant children of Polly Melt and thereupon the said William Barnes together with Jacob Barnes and Giles Barrett his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that the road leading from the sign post near Peter Morris to the fork of the road near Sipe Parkers, be added to the district of road now under the care of Henry Gardner and that the said Henry Gardner with the males labouring by thalls that usually work thereon keep the said road in repair according to Law.

Ordered that Henry Gurley, Henry B. Blougham, James Frequent & James Rochelle or any two of them let to the lowest undertaker the building of the abutments to the new bridges between Jerusalem and James Frequent and when the same are completed according to contract make report to Court.

Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor bind out Hardy Adams, Cordy Adams, Sam Adams, Richard Adams, Nancy Johnson, Polly Johnson, Peggy Johnson, Solence Johnson and Josiah Johnsons poor children according to Law.

The persons heretofore appointed to let the building of a bridge and causeways over the three creeks, this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "It is acknowledged and understood by the parties that the within bridges are to be of good timber, the posts and cap hills to be of oak or pine and of the same size and length of the former bridges, the bridge across the mill swamp to be twenty feet long with good buttends and timbers, which work the said undertaker binds himself in the within penalty to complete on or before 10th December next the covering of said bridge to be of pine planks of the thickness of two inches. Given under our hands this 24th day of July 1823, John Blommacke, George Inry."

An Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of Drury Neale dec^d was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of Ann Bishop dec^d was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Thomas Johnson is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from the bridge at Jerusalem to Mottoway Swamp Bridge in the room of Richard Williams discharged and it is ordered that the male labouring by thalls that usually work thereon assist in keeping the said road in repair.

Zachens Story is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from the fork of the road near the Cypress bridge to the cross road at Allens quarter in the
