Whereupon after mature deliberation, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Henry Briggs, Henry Gurley and Math. Calvert or any two of them having given public notice at the Courthouse of this County of the day of Sale for at least twenty days previous thereto, do proceed to sell to the highest bidder, upon a credit of nine months, except so much as will pay the expenses of this suit, which will be in cash, the slave Esther in the bill mentioned - that if the purchaser for the purpose of securing the payment of the purchase money remaining after the payment of the costs and expenses, he take two bonds with good security each for one moiety - that he pay over one of the said bonds to the legally appointed guardian of the complainant and the other to the guardian of the defendant Peggy Barrett - and that he make report thereof to Court in order to a final decree -

The Court doth assign Jacob Darden Guardian to Henrichy McLenny orphan of Henrichy McLenny deceased and thereupon the said Jacob Darden together with Simon Morfee and Wells Morfee his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs -

Upon the petition of Benjamin Cobb setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security for Charles W. Goddard and Harrietta his wife late Harrietta Turner guardian to James Turner and Elizabeth H. Turner orphans of Edmund Turner deceased and that he apprehends himself to be in danger of suffering thereby and praying the Court for relief. It is ordered that the said Charles W. Goddard and Harrietta his wife be summoned to the next Court to answer the said petition

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
