Whereupon after due consideration thereas this the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the tract of land lying in this County which descended to the female complainant and the defendants from their deceased father Thomas Cloughan containing two hundred and fifty acres including the reversion dependant upon the dower allotted in the same to Rebecca Cloughan widow of said Thomas Cloughan deceased be sold on a credit of twelve months and that the proceeds of the sale be divided into four equal parts and the payment of the same be secured by bonds with approved security, and one fourth part be delivered to the complainants in right of the said Martha A, and the remaining three fourths be allotted and delivered to the guardian of each of the infant defendants, and that a deed of conveyance be made to the purchaser of said land reserving to the said Rebecca Cloughan her dower in the same. It is also decreed and ordered that the eight slaves held in common between the complainants and defendants be divided equally in kind between the complainants so as to allot to the complainants one fourth part in value and to each of the defendants one fourth part. And it is moreover ordered that Seth Nicholas, Samuel Blunt, John W Blor and Thomas Fitzhugh or any three of them do carry the foregoing decree into effect, and such of them as may act do make a report to this Court of their proceedings herein in order to a final decree -
