This day came the parties by their Attorneys and the Commissioners appointed by an interlocutory decree made in this cause on the day of November 1822 to make sale of the tract of land in the proceedings mentioned this day made the following report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit. "In obedience to the aforesaid decree we the undersigned Commissioners met on the dinner land of Mr. Elizabeth Cook dec'd on the 5th day of December 1822 and sold the said land to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months - and Lawrence Cook became the purchaser for the sum of two thousand seven hundred and fifty one dollars and after deducting one hundred and twenty nine dollars for our commissions, there was a balance of two thousand six hundred and twenty two dollars which sum we divided as the decree directs viz. Eight hundred and seventy four dollars to Lawrence Cook (which is two sixths; four hundred and thirty seven dollars to Rue B. Pierce, which is one sixth, four hundred and thirty seven dollars to Elizabeth Fort, which is one sixth, two hundred & eight dollars & 50 cents to Nath. Rochelle (which is one half of one sixth), two hundred and eighteen dollars & 50 cents to John Turner, which is one half of one sixth, Eighty seven dollars and forty cents to Richard Williamson which is one fifth of one sixth. Eighty seven dollars and forty cents to Frank Edwards which is one fifth of one sixth. Eighty seven dollars & forty cents to Samuel Profess which is one fifths of one sixth, Eighty seven dollars and forty cents to Louisa Edwards which is one fifth of one sixth.
