A List of the Deeds & which have been admitted to record by the clerk in his office since the last term was this day returned and examined by the court and ordered to be recorded among the proceedings of the day

Ordered that Benjamin Giffen, James Pind and Richard Stephenson or any two of them do examine the state and settle an account current of the administration of Melchizedek Edmunds estates and make report thereof to court -

A writing purporting the nuncupative will of Jarrell Turner dec'd was presented in court by Benjamin Turner and Therupen Turner Newsum and Nathaniel Jones being sworn said the Test Tor in his last illness at his place of residence called upon them to take notice that he was in his senses and moreover that after his death and the payment of his just debts he gave to Mildred Palmer five hundred dollars and to his sister Sally Turner the balance of his estate, and if she died unmarried and without issue then and in that case he gave the same equally to the children of Benjamin Turner. Whereupon it is ordered that the same be established as and for the nuncupative will of the said Jarrell Turner dec'd and be recorded -

Ordered that William Bailey, Edward Bailey and John Harris or any two of them view the little Swamp bridge and report to the court whether the same has been completed according to contract or not -

James Briggs and Robert Nicholson are by Thomas Ridley Sheriff of this County appointed his deputies during his pleasure, and the court being of opinion that they are men of honesty probity and good demeanor they severally took the oaths prescribed by law -

On the motion of Benjamin Turner who made oath and together with John C. Turner and Henry Porter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned according to law certificate as granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Jarrell
