An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of John Francis dec^d was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Richard H. Plow having been appointed a Commissioner of the Revenue for this County, this day appeared in Court and entered into and acknowledged a bond with Security as the law directs which bond is ordered to be recorded.
