ground. We then proceeded to open to Polly Whelshhead formerly Beale as her  
dower for life our third part of said land by proper metes and bounds, in manner  
and form following, to wit. Beginning at a large pine in Trigshe Johnsons line  
thence along his line of marked trees to the river called B. water river thence  
down the run of S. River to the intersection of the long point gut and Black water  
river thence along the various meanders of the said long point gut to the high ground  
on the edge of the cornfield thence along the high water marks of the Islands of  
B. Water including the said place to a cypress a new corner made in the dower line  
standing on the edge of the low ground just below the lower C. of the said said  
place; thence a new line of marked trees to a path at the C. of the dwelling house  
thence along a new line of marked trees to the first station, containing 124 acres  
being her full proportion of S. Land as her dower for life. - Also lot N<sup>o</sup> 1 contain-  
ing 124 acres drawn by Martha Beal and bounded as follows to wit,  
Beginning at a cypress standing on the side of B. Water Islands thence  
along a new line of marked trees to a small red oak bush a new C. between  
lots N<sup>o</sup> 1 & 2. in Tabitha Fowlers line thence along her line to John  
Fowlers line thence along his line to Trigshe Johnsons line thence along  
his line to a point C. in the dower line, thence along the dower line of marked  
trees to the low grounds of B. Water river thence up the said low grounds of  
to the long point, thence along the long point first station being her full  
proportionable part of said land. - Also lot N<sup>o</sup> 2 containing 150 acres  
including the low grounds next to Mrs. Fowler, drawn by Polly Beale and  
bounded as follows to wit. Beginning at a cypress a new C. made between  
lots N<sup>o</sup> 1 & 2 running thence down the run of B. Water river to a small Cy-  
press a C. of Richard Murfee thence S. 76. W 158 pole through the Island  
to a small Sourwood in Tabitha Fowlers line thence along her line to a small  
red oak bush a new C. made in lots N<sup>o</sup> 1 & 2 thence along a new line of  
marked trees between lots N<sup>o</sup> 1 & 2 to the first station - being her full pro-  
portion of all the lands of her said father. Given under our hand this 10<sup>th</sup>  
day of January 1823. Amos Toyner, John Fowler. On consideration  
whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report afore-  
said in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable &  
binding forever and that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne  
between the said parties -
