Supra a negro man slave the property of Henry Dupree of the County of Brunswick who stands charged with breaking and entering the counting room and store room of David Vallance of Jerusalem in the County of Southampton Merchant, on the 23rd day of April 1834 in the night time at 8 O'Clock of the said night and feloniously and burglariously taking and carrying away from thence broadcloth of the value of eighty dollars, cambric, checks, calico, black silk handkerchiefs, flag-silk handkerchiefs &c of the value of two hundred dollars, two trunks containing banknotes up to the amount of fifteen thousand dollars - Banknotes to the amount of fifteen hundred dollars - Silver to the amount of two hundred dollars - two half eagles to the value of ten dollars - One trunk containing wearing apparel of the value of one hundred dollars and two guns of the value of thirty dollars of the goods and chattels of him the said David Vallance in the said counting room and store room then and there being, was set to the Bar by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid and being thereof arraigned pleaded not guilty and for his trial put himself upon God and the Count (The Count summoned for the trial of the said Supra having failed to meet) Thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises do with David Vallance & John H. Gurley

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
