that is to say the said Samuel Turner in the sum of two hundred dollars
and the said Harrison S. Griffin and Lawrence Soyner in the sum of one
hundred dollars each of their respective lands and tenements, goods and
chattels to be levied and to our said Governor and his executors for the use of
the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Sam-
uel Turner shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour toward all the
citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Jeremiah
Soyner for the space of two years from this time then the above recognizance
to be void or else to remain in full force -
