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Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine State and settle an account of Thomas E Cobb's Guardianship of Elvira Collier - An account of Benjamin Cobb's Guardianship of Joseph Drury, and an account of Joseph Snyers ^{and} ~~and~~ on J. Snyers estate and make separate reports thereof to Court.

On the motion of Schabod Johnson It is ordered that John Fowler the Executor named in the last Will and Testament of James Fowler ^{de} be summoned to the next Court to qualify.

By consent of Charles W Goodwyn guardian to the Orphans of Edmund Turner deceased, with the assent of the Court it is ordered that the guardianship - aforesaid be taken from the hands of the said Goodwyn, and it is ordered that Benjamin Turner be appointed guardian to the said orphans upon his entering into bond with sufficient security conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Benjamin Cobb, John Williams and Thomas R Gray or any two of them do view the ground through which the road is proposed to be turned near Jeremiah Cobbs and William Bells, as well as the present road and report to the Court the comparative conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such road be altered as proposed.

The persons appointed to view the ground along which a road is proposed to be turned by Russell Bryant this day make the following report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit: "Southampton County. Pursuant to the annual order of the undersigned have viewed the ground where a road is proposed to be run by Russell Bryant as well as the old Road, and report that the conveniences and inconveniences which will result either to the public or to individuals by turning the road agreeably to the wish of the applicant Bryant are comparatively equal. But the conveniences that will result to the said Bryant therefrom will be considerable. Given under my hands this 15th day of May 1822. Lawrence Cook, Richard Blunt, W. T. Phillips." Whereupon it is ordered that leave be given the said Bryant to alter the said road as petitioned for.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in course -
