Nancy Nicholson widow and relief of Robert Nicholson deceased Plaintiff
against

Henry Briggs, executor of the said Robert Nicholson deceased, and Robert James, Sally, George, and Albert Nicholson infant children of said Robert Nicholson by William Briggs their natural friend & Robert Gray and Mary Ann his wife late Nicholson Defendants.

This day came the parties by their Attorneys and the persons appointed by the interlocutory decree made in this cause at March Court 1822 to make allotment and division of the lands and slaves therein mentioned this day made their report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words.

"Agreeably to a decree of Southampton County Court bearing date March Court 1822, Mr. Samuel Barham and Barbara Brown Commissioners thereupon appointed Report, that being attended by William Dobb deputy of J. H. Watkins Surveyor of Sussex County, we proceeded to have all the lands whereof Robert Nicholson died seized and possessed lying in the County of Southampton, surveyed and found the mansion house tract to contain four hundred and five acres, and the tract called and known by the name of the Corp road tract to contain Seven hundred and Sixty seven acres making in the total eleven hundred and seventy two acres which after having regard to quality as well as quantity we were of opinion that two hundred and eighty and a half acres which we had cut off from the original mansion house tract by a new made dividing line beginning near Nicholsons gate & running down Nicholsons lane towards the house due North 98 pole to a stob in lane near corner of the fence thence S 89 W 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ p. to a stob a corner pine for 60d dower thence N 2 E 140 p. to main run of Raccoon Swamp, no corner tree, is sufficient for dower in the lands aforesaid, and do hereby assign to Nancy Nicholson widow and relief of said deceased the above mentioned two hundred and eighty and a half acres of land as her dower therin. We then proceeded to value the slaves whereof said Robert died possessed without regard to the particular interest which the said Robert Nicholson or his estate had or hath in them and do hereby assign to Nancy Nicholson widow and Relief of said deceased as her dower for and during her natural life and no longer, the following slaves to wit, namely Fred, Luckey, & child, Maria, Amy, Billy Sam, Henry, John and Moses Given under our hands this fourteenth day of March Anno domini eighteen hundred and twenty three. Samuel Barham
Barbara Brown." On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the said Nancy Nicholson hold the land and slaves as aforesaid allotted to her as and for her dower in the estate of her deceased husband Robert Nicholson estate.
