Catharine Lawrence or their issue as the case may be - allotting one share to
Polly and one to Catharine Lawrence and dividing the remaining one equally
among the four children of the said Sarah Lawrence *de.:* *Ally. Sarah Eley,*
by Nancy his wife, in right of his said wife - Isaac Sniffen and Elizabeth his
wife in right of his said wife, Benjamin Crumpler and Amy his wife in
right of his said wife and Robert Lawrence. That the said Commissioners
then take one other ninth part of the said paternal half, being that to
*which John Boykin *de.:* the uncle of the said intestate would if alive*
have been entitled and subdivide it into three parts for his three children
or the issue as the case may be and allot one third to his son John Boykin
one to Patience Boykin and divide the other third equally among the
*four infant children of Edwin Boykin *de.:* to wit. James, Frederick,*
Martha & Edwin Boykin. That the said Commissioners then take one
other ninth part of the said paternal half, being that to which Patience
Turner formerly Boykin would if alive have been entitled and subdivide it
into five parts for her five children or their issue as the case may be and

Barrett her three living daughters, that they then divide another fifth
equally among Jacob, James, & Patience Turner the children of Solomon

ing ninth part of the said paternal half of the estate, being that to which

divide the remaining fifth equally among the three infant children of

Cutchings Pasture and Boykin Pasture -
That the said Commissioners then divide the one of the said Estate
set apart for the Maternal relations of the said intestate into five
equal parts for the five maternal uncles and aunts or their issue as
herein after specified. That they then allot one such fifth to Charles
Bailey & one to William Bailey that they then take one other such fifth
*part of the said maternal half, being that to which Barbara Jenkins *de.:**
formerly Bailey would have been entitled if alive and subdivide it into four
