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equal shares for her four children or their issue as the case may be and allot and allot one share to W. F. Jenkins, one to John Whitfield & Lucy his wife in right of his said wife - one to Polly Swallow formerly Jenkins and divide the remaining fourth equally among four children of John Jenkins dec'd. to wit. Edmund, Silas, Elizabeth & Nancy Jenkins - That the said Commissioners then take one other fifth part of the said Maternal half being that to which Heartwell Bailey dec'd. would have if alive, been entitled and subdivide it into five equal shares and allot them to his five children as follows to wit. one share to Robert Mercer and Nancy his wife in right of his said wife, one share to William Borden and Pamela his wife in right of his said wife - one to Anna Bailey - one to Sufe Bailey and the remaining share to Drury Burnett & Polly his wife late Bailey in right of his said wife. That the said Commissioners then take the remaining fifth part of the said Maternal half of the estate, being that to which Peter Bailey dec'd. would if alive have been entitled and subdivide it into four equal shares among his four children and allot them as follows to wit. one share to John Bailey, one to Sally Bailey, one to James Bailey and one to Francis Bailey - And the said Commissioners having carried this decree into effect are ordered to report their proceedings in the premises to this Court in order to a final decree -

On the motion of John Fowler one of the Executors named in the Will of James Fowler deceased who took the oath of an Executor and together with William Fowler, Matthew Fowler and David B. Counsel his securities entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him to be joined in the probate of the said Will.

Ordered that Benjamin Griffin, Matthew Gardner, James D. Maysburg and Jordan Edwards or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James Fowler deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -

The said doth officer Benjamin Turner guardian to James and Elizabeth Turner orphans of Edmund Turner deceased and thereupon the said Benjamin Turner together with Chas. Whitlock and Harry Porter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs -

The last Will and Testament of Sam Harris deceased was proved by the oath of Miles Horn and Robert Capell the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

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
