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by Counsel. On Consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the injunction awarded the plaintiffs on the day of July 1816 to enjoin the defendant Simon Boykin from further proceedings on the forthcoming bonds in the bill mentioned, be dissolved as to the two bonds mentioned on the deposition of Edwards Bull's Tutors and filed in this cause, executed by John Bull's and others to the defendant Simon Boykin as surviving obligee of himself and Solomon Holmes dec'd. which bonds are to be credited for the sum of three dollars paid by the said John Bull's. That the plaintiffs' bill be dismissed and that they pay to the defendants their costs by them about their defence in this behalf expended.

On the motion of John Bull's. It is ordered that Edwards M. Sand and Martha his wife late Martha Bull's be summoned to May Court next to give counter security for the faithful administration of James Bull's Estate.
