Counsel On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that
the said report in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and
stable and be forever binding.

On the motion of Alexander Booth who filed his bill an Injunction is
awarded him to stay until the further order of this Court all proceedings on a
judgment therein obtained by Margaret Croalin administratrix of James
Croalin dec'd against the said Alexander Booth, upon his entering into bond
with security according to Law in the Clerk's Office of this Court within two months
and filing a release of all errors at Law in the said judgment proceedings.

On the motion of Josiah Murdaugh who filed his bill, and made oath
thereto according to Law an Injunction is awarded him to stay until the further
order of this Court all proceedings on a judgment therein obtained by Thomas
Ridley and William B. Goodwyns attorns with the will executed of Thomas
Ridley dec'd against the said Josiah Murdaugh, upon his entering into
bond with security according to Law in the Clerk's Office of this Court and
filing a release of all errors at Law in the said judgment proceedings.

The Court doth assign Simon Messier guardian to Callie, Mar-
tha, and Margaret Edwards infant children of Tyler Edwards, and of
Leahy, John and Martha Edwards infant children of Jeremiah E.
