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the defendants have had legal notice of the motion they were solemnly called but
came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against
the said defendants the sum of One hundred and eighty seven dollars and
ninety eight cents the penalty of the said bond and his costs by him about his
motion in this behalf expended And the said defendants in mercy &c.
But this execution may be discharged by the payment of Ninety three dollars
and ninety nine cents with legal interest thereon from the 5th day March
1823 till paid and the costs -

The Summons heretofore awarded against Richard Murfee requiring him to
appear and give good Counter Security for his Guardianship of the orphans of
William Fowler having been returned executed and the said Richard Murfee hav-
ing failed to appear this solemnly called. It is ordered that the said Richard
Murfee be displaced as guardian aforesaid. and the Court do thereupon assign
Matthew Gardner Guardian to Francis and Henry Fowler orphans of William
Fowler dec^d. whereupon the said Matthew Gardner with Schabed Johnson & Abraham
Lawrence his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of
three thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs -

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb do examine state and settle an
account Current of Richard Murfee's Guardianship of the orphans of William
Fowler dec^d. and make report thereof to Court -

Present. James Jones. Gent.

James Toller and Jordan Beale of the County of Alle of Wight who stand
charged with feloniously, stealing, taking and carrying away from Nelson Forest
sixteen oranges of the value of two dollars of the goods and chattels of the said
Forest. This day appeared in Court according to the condition of their recognizance
entered into and the securities from their recognizance and undertaking in this
behalf are discharged, and the said James Toller and Jordan Beale were set
to the bar by the Sheriff of this County and charged with the felony aforesaid
(the Court summoned for their examination not having met) and thereupon
divers witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth
touching the premises, to wit, James Millikin, Shadrach Tuttle, Samuel
Kello, and Nicholas Maget. The Court after hearing the testimony and all
the circumstances of the Case are of opinion that the prisoners are not guilty
And thereupon proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further
appearing or being alleged ^{against} the prisoners it is ordered that they be forthwith
discharged from further prosecution in this behalf -
