A List of the several Deeds admitted to record in the Clerk's Office since the last Court was this day returned by the Clerk of this Court according to Law and was inspected by the Court and ordered to be recorded -

On the motion of James W. Parker and James Rochelle who made oath and together with Clement Rochelle and Samuel B. Harris their securities entered into and acknowledged above in the sum of five thousand dollars conditioned according to Law certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Francis P. Williamson dec'd. in due form -

Ordered that Henry Hurley, James Melcher, Meriwether M. Brodnax, Robert Godwin and George H. Gray or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal Estate of Francis P. Williamson deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent moneys in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to Nicholas L. Williams the sum of four hundred and sixty eight dollars for rebuilding Carys bridge and account with the Court -

Ordered that Master Commissioners Cobb settle an account of Julia Boykin's guardianship of Salina Boykin and make report to this Court -

James W. Parker is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from Solks crop roads to the Super line near Temperance Springs in the town of Wilkinson Chapel discharged.

Ordered that Master Commissioners Cobb settle an account of Edward D. Lundy's administration on Lunsfords Lundy's estate and make report thereof to Court -

Richard B. Day who was bound by Recognizance for his appearance here this day appeared in discharge of the said recognizance, and thereupon the securities for his appearance from their recognizance is discharged, and the said Richard B. Day was fully heard by Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion and do accordingly order that the said Richard B. Day find Security for his good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the space of twelve calendar months from this day, himself in the sum of \$200 and two securities in the sum of \$100 each and in default thereof that he be committed to Jail. Whereupon the said Richard B. Day with John Barham and Giles Reed his securities here in Court acknowledged themselves indebted unto his excellency James Pleasants Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth and his Successors in Office, the said Richard B. Day in the sum of two hundred dollars and

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
