his said Securities in the sum of One hundred dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be lent and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Richard B Day shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the space of twelve calendar months from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Ordered that the Estate of said Peter Moore deceased be committed to the hands of the Sheriff of this County and that he administer thereon according to Law.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of Peter Moore dec^d. was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Upon the petition of James Bond petitioning for the that he is bound in the bond of Security of Patrick Bond as Guardian of John Hill and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by reason thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is ordered that the said Patrick Bond be summoned to the next Court to answer the said petition.

Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor of this County be and Raulen Butler and James Crocker poor children to George B. Gray according to Law.

Elizabeth Kendrick widow and relict of Abner Kendrick deceased appeared in Court and declared that she will not take or accept the provision made for her by his will or any part thereof and renounced all benefit which she might claim under the said will.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court by the affidavit of James Ingram, William L. Everitt, Alexander S. Pate, and Nathaniel Stinson taken in open Court that Robert Fort late of this County is of insane mind and died on the 15th of April last leave his residence and hath not since been heard of. Therefore on the motion of Samuel Barham with the consent of Nancy Miller the mother of the said Robert Fort. It is ordered that the estate of the said Robert Fort be committed to the hands of the said Samuel Barham to be administered on according to Law till the further order of this Court. Whereupon the said Samuel Barham with John Barham, Henry S. Mulbrook and Barham Warren his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond conditioned as the Law directs.

Samuel B. Davis Gent. this day appeared in Court and qualified to a Commission appointing him Lieutenant Colonel of the 65th Regiment of the Virginia Militia which is ordered to be entered of Record.
