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Worrell and John Spenser his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$5000 conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form. Sally Carr the widow and relict and executrix named in the said will appeared in Court and renounced the executorship, and also declared, that she will not take or accept the provision made for her by the said will or any part thereof and renounced all benefit which she might claim by the said will.

Ordered that Joseph Pope, Nathan Pope jr John Spenser and Jacob Williams or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of John Carr deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ann Lewis orphan of Jubelin Lewis deceased with the approbation of the Court made charge of Richard Blunt for her Guardian and thereupon the said Richard Blunt together with William B Goodwyn and James D Massey his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Jepe Drury, Richard B Blon and James Murdaugh severally appeared in Court and severally gave bonds and security and qualified as Constables in this County according to Law.

Ordered that Jeremiah Cobb, Edwards Battle, John Williams and Benjamin Cobb or any three of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge across Colliers mill pond and make report thereof to Court.

Stephen Hurst and Exum Vick free negroes this day severally appeared in Court according to the conditions of their recognizances entered into for their appearance, and thereupon their securities from their recognizances and undertaking on this behalf are discharged and the said Stephen Hurst and Exum Vick were set to the bar by the Sheriff of this County and charged with burglariously breaking and entering the house of James Story of this County on the night of the day of June last past and carrying therefrom gallons of brandy gallons of wine and pounds of tobacco (The Court soon moved for their recapture not having met) and thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Com. in order to catch touching the premises to wit, James Story others and the prisoner being fully heard by Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case and of opinion that the prisoners are not guilty, and thereupon proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against them it is ordered that they be discharged from further prosecution in this behalf.
