Ordered that Lewis A Branch, Samuel Bailey, Charles Bailey, & Orson Branch or any three of them being first duly sworn according to law do appraise all the personal estate of Benjamin L Hancock decd. and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -

Henry Gardner who was bound by recognizance for his appearance here this day appeared accordingly and therewith his securities from their recognizance in this behalf entered into as discharged and the prosecution in this case being solemnly called and not appearing it is ordered that the said defendant be forthwith discharged from further prosecution in this behalf -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning 9 of Oct.
