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being able to find no such tree. To remove this difficulty your Commissioners determined to survey two tracts of land the one granted to Richard Lane in the year 1726 the other granted to Robert Jones dec^d in the year 1739 both calling for the above mentioned white oak supposing the junction of the two lines would mark out the spot where the white oak formerly stood. This point your Commissioners ascertain to be a hickory tree a little back of the store house lately occupied by Nathan Jones dec^d in the time of William B. Goddard. accordingly your Commissioners started from the above mentioned Hickory tree and run a line South seventy nine degrees east to a cypress tree in the Angelica Swamp at the mouth of the Beaver Pond as directed by the will of James Jones and given under our hands this 16th day of August 1823. Spradley Williams, Wm B. Goddard, Roberton Supple. On consideration whereof and by consent of parties by their Counsel it is decreed and ordered that the said report be confirmed and that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne between the parties.

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Isaac Dille dec^d was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

The last Will and Testament of Francis Bhent dec^d was proved by the oath of Martha Holladay, a subscribing witness thereto and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Lawrence Cook who made oath and together with Edwin Turner his Security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted him for returning letters of administration on the Estate of Miles Cook dec^d in due form.

Leticia Hicks (a single white woman of this County having been delivered of a bastard child and on examination on oath charged Robert Magee with being the father of the said child. and the said Robert Magee here in Court confessed himself to be the father of the said bastard child. Therefore it is ordered that the said Robert Magee find Security for the maintenance and support of the said child for the space of six years from this day in the sum of \$120 and five securities in the sum of \$20 each in case the said child should live so long and in default thereof that he be committed to Jail. Whereupon the said Robert Magee with William West, Shadrach Boykin, James Holt, & Joseph Russ (of John, his securities here in Court, acknowledged themselves indebted unto his excellency James Pleasants Esq. Governor or chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth and his Successors in Office himself in the sum of \$120 and his said securities in the sum of \$30. But upon this condition that if the said Robert Magee shall pay to the Overseer of the poor the sum of \$20 annually for the space of six years from this day for and towards the maintenance and support of said bastard child if the said child shall live so long then this recognizance to be void other to remain in full force and virtue.
