Whereupon on the motion of the said Wilson Willens who made oath & together with John Exum and Matthew Moulford his securities hereunto entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Henry Lunt, Joseph Lane, Jesse Crocker and Willie Moller or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Robert Willens dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Alexander Briggs who made oath and together with Rufus Branch and James Bell his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs to certify to be granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Averilla Jones dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Burnell Barnett Eli Locker, William West and John Morris or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Averilla Jones dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
