Whereupon on the motion of the said Wilson Wiltons who made oath & together with John Evans and Matthew Mountford his securities herein countersigned into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.

Ordered that Henry Amort Joseph Lane, Sepe Croker and Willie Mollins or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Robert Wiltons dec<sup>d</sup> and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -

On the motion of Alexander Briggs who made oath and together with Bryan Branch and James Bell his securities entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certified is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Averilla Jones dec<sup>d</sup> in due form -
