Bynum who so conceals himself that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him for Two hundred and Twenty five dollars with interest from the 19th day of May 1823 due by bond. and the Sheriff having made return that he had executed the said attachment, and summoned Richard Bynum as garnisher. This day came the plaintiff by his Attorney and the defendant not appearing. Richard Bynum the garnisher appeared and being sworn acknowledged that he owed the said Robert S. Bynum the sum of Two hundred dollars. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant the said sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars with legal interest thereon from the 19th day of May 1823 his debt aforesaid proved to be just and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended. And it is ordered that the said plaintiff recover against the said Richard Bynum the aforesaid sum of Two hundred dollars with legal interest thereon from this day towards satisfying this judgment.

On the motion of Richard B. Kello. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes and levies in future for his negro woman Asia she being aged and infirm.
