This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and the assent of the Court and came on to be heard on the bill, answer, exhibit and argument of Counsel. Upon consideration whereof, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that William B Gorder, Spradley Williams and John McGlenn or any two of them do attend by some competent survey or divide the land, allot to the Defendant Temperance Parker one fourth part in value of the land and negroes, and other property remaining of deceased estate or such portion of said estate as shall be agreeable to her, provided the same shall not exceed in value one fourth part of the same. And that of the surplus, they allot one equal third part to the complainant James W, one to Solomon D and the remainder to Joseph H. And how they shall have acted in the premises make report in order to a final decree --

On the motion of Barkham Warrum setting forth that he is bound in this Court as proxy for John Butts as guardian of Judith Butts orphan of William Butts dec'd and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by reason thereof, and praying the Court for relief.
