Sub Chancery

This day the cause came on to be heard upon the bill and answer of the parties. Whereupon and on mature consideration the Court doth order, adjudge and decree, that Saul Williams, Richard Darden and Bailey Bryant or any two of them, do either with or without the County Surveyor sell the land situated on the Buckhorn creek of which Robert Miller died seized, after giving reasonable notice of the time and place of sale to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months, and of the purchaser take four bonds with approved security of equal amounts, one of which they shall assign to James H Bryant and Sarah E Bryant his wife one to Nancy R Miller, one to James E Miller and one to William R Miller the two last to James H Bryant their guardian for their benefit, and report thereof to the Court in order to a final decree -

Sub Chancery

This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and adjourned of the Court and was heard on the bill and answer and argument of counsel. Whereupon the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the tract of land lying in this County containing by estimation One hundred acres, whereof John A Washington died, seized and possessed, be sold on a credit of twelve months, except the amount of the costs of this suit which will be for cash, and that the proceeds of the sale be divided into three equal parts to be secured by bond with approved security, and one bond to be allotted to each of the defendants and one to the guardian of the plaintiff. And it is moreover decreed that Elias Sammons, Edward A Branch, Harrison Stephenson and James B Meguihart or any three of them do, after giving reasonable public notice of the time and place of sale, carry the foregoing decree into effect, and make report thereof to the Court in order to a final decree -
