The Commissioners appointed under the interlocutory decree made in
 this cause at November Court 1822 to make sale of the Tract of land in the
 proceedings mentioned this day made a report in these words to wit.
 "In compliance with the decree hereto annexed the undersigners after giving
 reasonable notice of the time and place of the sale of the Lands specified in the said
 decree did sell at public sale to the highest bidder, said Lands on the term of
 twelve months credit to be given the purchaser, to which Lemuel Story one of the
 parties in s^d decree became the s^d purchaser for the sum of seven hundred
 and fifty six dollars of which sum he the said Lemuel Story (agreeable to s^d
 decree) was entitled to one fifth part of the s^d sum. And for the remaining
 four fifths we the said undersigners did require and take of him the s^d Lemuel
 Story four separate bonds with approved security to the amount of one hundred
 hundred and fifty six dollars and Twenty cents each, which s^d bonds we have
 assigned. One to Zachariah Story, One to Lemuel Story, One to Benjamin Story
 and the remaining one we now return to the Court to be deposited in the
 Clerk's Office there to remain until some person or persons apply for the
 same with legal authority to demand and receive the same for the benefit
 of Thomas, Samuel, Harriet, Amanda, Louisa, Jane, Mary, Martha &
 Emeline Eliza Story infant children of Jesse Story dec'd agreeable to s^d
 decree. To which we have herunto set our hands in order to a final
 decree. James Bishop, John Spencer, Ex^{rs} Clerk." Whereupon by consent
 of parties by their counsel it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid
 in manner and form as aforesaid made be confirmed, and be held firm, stable
 and binding between the parties forever. And that the costs of this suit be
 proportionally borne between the said parties -
