This day came the parties by their Commiss and the Commissioner appointed
under the interlocutory decree made in this cause at November Court last to make
Sale of the land therein mentioned this day made the following report to my

"In conformity to the annexed decree I Benjamin Griffen have after giving
due notice of the same sold to the highest bidder for ready money the land and
plantation wherein Mary Clarke died bequeath (a woman of colors) which land
was sold for the purpose of making a division between Robertson Clarke & John
Clarke heirs of the said Mary Clarke, and the said Robertson Clarke having
purchase of his three sisters their proportions and titles to said land which makes
him entitled to four fifths of the same and the above named John only one
fifth and James Maser became the purchaser for the sum of one hundred
and twenty three dollars - deducting therefrom five dollars for the service which
was the Lawyers charge, five dollars for commiss & three dollars &
sixty three cents Clarke making the sum of \$13.63 cts - the amount
of expenses taken from the amount of sale leaves one hundred and nine dollars
thirty seven cents - four fifths of this sum allotted to the said Robertson man-
king \$87.50 cents and one fifth to the said John making \$21.87 cents all
which I have paid over to the said Robertson in right of himself and as Guar-
dian to the said John Clarke - all which acts and doings is respectfully
submitted to the Court. Given under my hand this 28th day of November 1823.
Benjamin Griffen Commiss." On consideration whereof and by consent of parties
it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid
made be held firm and stable and be binding forever between the parties -
