This day came the parties by their Counsel and the Commissioner appointed under the interlocutory decree made in this cause at November Court last to make sale of the land therein mentioned this day made the following report to wit:
 "In conformity to the annexed decree I Benjamin Griffin have after giving due notice of the same, sold to the highest bidder for ready money the land and plantation wherein Mary Clarke died seised (a woman of colour) which land was sold for the purpose of making a division between Robertson Clarke & John Clarke heirs of the said Mary Clarke, and the said Robertson Clarke having purchased of his three sisters their proportions and titles to said land, which makes him entitled to four fifths of the same and the above named John only one fifth and James Claider became the purchaser for the sum of one hundred and twenty three dollars - deducting therefrom five dollars for the decree which was the Lawyers charge, five dollars for commissions & three dollars & sixty three cents clerk fees making the sum of \$13.63 cents - the amount of expenses taken from the amount of sales leaves one hundred and nine dollars thirty seven cents - four fifths of this sum allotted to the said Robertson making \$87.50 cents and one fifth to the said John making \$21.87 cents all which I have paid over to the said Robertson in right of himself and as Guardian to the said John Clarke - all which actings and doings is respectfully submitted to the Court. Given under my hand this 28th day of November 1825. Benjⁿ Griffin Commr." On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and be binding forever between the parties -
