On the motion of Mary Smith who made oath and together with John Womack and David Mussum her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Solomon Smith dec^d in due form -

Ordered that Thomas Moore Henry Harrison, Henry Moore and Benjamin Harrison or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Solomon Smith dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court -
