by the said Henry Blow to the defendant Mary D. Blow and which she may
choose to surrender for that purpose be sold on a credit of one, two and three
years reasonable public notice of the time and place being first given,
and that the proceeds of the sale be divided into five equal parts and secured
by bonds with approved security, and that one bond be assigned over to the
Complainant Robert Goodwyn in right of his wife Margaret W. and one
to the guardian of each of the defendants, James Henry, Robert & Samuel
Blow. And it is moreover ordered that Benjamin Blunt jr. do carry
the foregoing decree into effect and make a conveyance in fee simple with
special warranty, to the purchaser of said land and make a report to this
Court in order to a final decree. And six months are allowed the infant
defendants after they arrive to lawful age to contest this decree.
