Whereupon and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and be binding forever between the parties -

Edwin G. Hart, Temperance Harrison, Ephraim Elliott, owner of his late wife Peggy, William Elliott, an infant son of said Ephraim and Peggy Elliott by his next friend Edwin G. Hart, and Benjamin Britt and Elizabeth his wife.

This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and absent of the court and was heard on the bill, answer and arguments of counsel. Whereupon the court doth adjudge, order and decree that the tract of land lying in this County containing about two hundred and fifty four acres of which William Hart dec. seized he divided into three equal parts having regard to value, and that one fourth be allotted to the Complainants in right of the Complainant Lucy, one third part to Benjamin Britt and his wife Elizabeth in right of his said wife and the remaining third part to the defendant William Elliott subject to the life estate therein of the defendant Ephraim Elliott. It is moreover adjudged ordered and decreed the slaves with their subsequent increase which were allotted to the widow of the said William Hart be divided into four equal parts and that one part be allotted the Complainants in right of the Complainant Lucy, one part to the defendant Ephraim Elliott owner of his late wife Peggy, one to the defendant Benjamin Britt and his wife Elizabeth and that the remainder be sold on a credit of twelve months, and the proceeds of the sale be divided into five equal parts to be secured by bond with approved security and allotted in the following manner among the distributees of Henry W. Hart dec. one to the Complainants, one to the defendant Edwin G. Hart, one to the defendant Temperance Harrison, one to the defendant Benjamin Britt and wife and the remaining one to the defendant William Elliott. And it is further ordered that Jacob Darden, Sipe Parker, Etheldred Warren and Leonard Holt or any three of them do carry the foregoing decree into effect and make report to the court in what manner they have done the same in order to a final decree -

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
