And it is further adjudged, ordered and decreed that the Slaves Diley, Tom, Mary, Minerva, Jimmy and Pella mentioned in the complainants be equally divided between the complainants and defendants is to each of them an equal part in value. It is moreover ordered that Cass Dorris, John Morris, William J. Jones and Jonathan Luter or any three of them do carry the foregoing decree into effect, that they make a deed of conveyance in fee simple without warranty to the purchaser of said land, and that they make a report to this Court in what manner they have acted in order to a final decree.
