in the following words to wit: "By virtue of the annexed decree in the undersigned
commissioners have proceeded (with the assistance of the County Surveyor)
and have laid off to Harriett Bond the widow of Calthrop Bond dec'd 244 acres of
land to her as and for her dower in the land that Calthrop Bond dec'd seized
having regard to quality as well as quantity, that leaving 128 acres acres
which belongs to Francis C & Archer P Bond's orphan of the said Calthrop
Bond dec'd which is to be divided between them at a future day making 172
acres of land in the whole. We have also allotted to the said Harriett Bond
the following Slaves namely Jimmy valued at \$300 Eason at \$300 Jacob at
\$75 & Easter at \$50 amounting to \$725 which lacks \$8.34 cent of ma-
king one third part of the valuation of all the slaves which she is to
receive from the children which is allotted to her as her dower in the same for
and during her life the remaining part of the slaves, to wit, Monus valued
at \$100. da Jim \$75 Rose at \$275. Sam \$375. Molly at \$300 Amy at \$300
Drew \$50 Liddy \$50 and Nancy \$50 amounting to \$1475 which is \$8.34
cent over two thirds of the whole valuation which we have allotted to Francis
C & Archer P Bond as their proper proportion of the same which is to be
divided between at a future day as by the decree we are directed - all
which actings and doings is respectfully submitted to the Court Given
under our hands this 30th day of December 1823. Wm Griffith, Wm Ricks
Wiley Wellons." Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that
this report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm
and stable and be binding between the parties forever -
