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which is included - and Wilson Wellons became the purchaser for the sum of \$502 and after deducting from that sum \$28.38 cents for Commissions, Lawyers & Clerks fees leaves the sum of \$473.62 cents which we have divided into seven equal parts. there being that many distributees, making to each one the sum of \$67.66 cents and have taken seven bonds with sufficient security to the same for the sum of \$67.66 cents and have assigned one bond to Wilson Wellons the Complainant, one to Robert Wellons for the same amount, one to Henry Gardner and Polly his wife late Wellons, for the same amount, one to Dorcas Wellons for the same amount, one to Asa Wellons for the same amount, one to Ira Wellons for the same amount and one to Charles Wellons for the same amount all due Twelve months after date - All which acting and doing is respectfully Submitted to the Court Given under our hands this 31st day of January 1824. Bay Griffin Rich^d Wells, Wiley Wellons - On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and be binding forever between the parties -
